  - Try to avoid using a zoom if using a touch screen device so it
  - Keep the photo straight, with edges parallel to the frame
- Think of a paragraph that describes what you've done and why
  - Was this a new craft activity?
  - Was it a request by a friend or loved one?
  - How has it helped during your lockdown?
  - How has creatively made you feel during lockdown?
